PL tone = 123.0 From Rockingham to Rest Stop 5. Will be linked with 147.195 (Florence) and Cheraw 146.895 (Pageland). May unlink after all past Rest Stop 5.
- 146.895 - Rusty George, WD4HEM Cheraw, SC
PL tone = 123.0 From Weddington to Rest Stop E or F. Will be linked to 145.490 (Cheraw). May Pageland unlink after all into Cheraw 145.490 coverage area, or if traffic on the link is excessive.
- 146.745 - Danny Hampton, K4ITL Raleigh, NC
Dillon Second half of Rockingham and Weddington routes.
- 446.100 Tactical - note frequency carefully! Chosen to avoid certain QRM from pickup
Simplex trucks. Use for SAG to SAG or for adjacent rest stops.
- Backup 147.135 Backup from Chesterfield and Cheraw areas of route through Rest Stop 6. Use for
Chesterfield routine backup comms.
- Camden Route 146.925 (-600) in Bishopville, SC
at Rest Stop 7 switch to 146.850 (+600) in Florence, SC

PL tone = 100.0 Use from Marion to Rest Stop 7. Linked to 146.655 (Myrtle Beach).

PL tone = 100.0 Linked to 147.090 (Aynor). Good from Rest Stop 7 to end of the route.
